



District 1 (Do) and 3 (Wagner) up for election (Both Republicans)


Janet Nguyen will run in District 1 (incl HB) against Van Tran

## State Measures on Primary Ballot

- SCA 2 Forced Low Income Housing
- ACA 5 Marriage is for Anyone
  - SEC. 7.5. (a) The right to marry is a fundamental right.
- ACA 1 Lowers local property tax and debt voter approval from 2/3 to 55%
- 13 cleared for circulation including ONV, Legalize mushrooms, Various education, etc
- 13 with AG for title and wording, including Election Integrity, Education choice, No sex mutilation, Girls sports, etc

#### **Proposed City Charter Amendment 1**

- Shall proposed Charter Amendment No. 1 to:
  - Require Voter ID for elections, more in-person voting locations, monitoring of drop boxes
  - Clarify that voters elect the City Attorney as the City's legal councsel free from interference from City officials
  - And clarify budget authority for the City Attorney's Office
  - Update qualifications for City Clerk
  - And stop potential wrongdoing by requiring alleged malfeasance by City official be investigated by outside agencies be approved?

#### **Proposed City Charter Amendment 2**

- Shall proposed Charter amendment 2 to:
  - Provide that the only flags that shall be displayed bu the City on City property are the United State, County of Orange, City of Huntington Beach Flags, and the POW Flag and Flags of the Armed Forces
  - Require the Cty to adopt a Two-Year Budget, and
  - Move the City Clerk and City Treasurer elections to the gubernatorial election cycle be approved?

#### **Proposed City Charter Amendment 3**

- Shall proposed Charter amendment No. 3 to:
  - Require voter approval of any City transaction that forgives, waives, or foregoes the collection of property in excess of \$100,000 per year, except acquisition of property for parks and infrastructure;
  - Update exceptions to Section 612 (Measure C) to allow certain children's playground equipment, park related utility structures and public restrooms be built or improved without limitation;
  - And update the procedures to cancel a regular City Council meeting, be approved?
